Leviathan Fuzz

Thank you for your purchase of the Leviathan Fuzz! This unique Wampler Pedals fuzz is a thunderous beast designed to make a fuzz lover out of the staunchest distortion pedal advocate. From the rumble of the deep to the primal roar, Leviathan brings together the goals of having a focused, cutting tone while still providing massive but controllable fuzz and distortion. If this is your first fuzz, the control setup should help you in exploring uncharted waters... but be careful, here there be dragons!

Controls

Bass: Adjusts the low frequency content of the fuzz. Simple enough, but things can get a little dangerous around this fuzz. If you're not careful balancing the deep frequencies, you might feel the undertow!

Treble: Adjusts the high frequency content of the fuzz. Again, everyone knows what treble is for, but this pedal has serious teeth, and this knob allows you to decide how much bite you want.

Gain: Provides more or less fuzz and distortion depending on adjustment. Warning: users may experience a desire to crank the gain. We say, go with it.

Volume: Controls output level... or is it a safety cage to allow you to swim in the deep with the Leviathan? It's both. But mostly it controls output level.

Rumble/Roar: Switches between GE and SI diodes, allowing you to more precisely shape the nature of the sound between a more compressed but gainier sound, or an open, throaty tone. Let your imagination guide you... switch it a few times to get the hang of its sound, and from then on you'll know when you want to rumble, and when you want roar. Rumble is low but massively powerful; roar is higher and has lots of cut, though a bit less gain.

If using a power supply, power needed for the pedal is 9vdc center pin negative, just like most standard $Boss^{TM}/Ibanez^{TM}/Etc.$ type pedals. My favorite is the Visual Sound One spotTM.

There is a battery connection inside, if you would like to use it you will need to open the bottom plate and insert a battery.

Warranties

There is a 7-day "no questions asked" period where you may return the pedal if you do not like the sound of it. You will need to pay for shipping to us, however, and if anything is damaged or broken (except for malfunction or premature wear) we will have to deduct that from the refund. The 7 days start upon receipt of pedal. This is not valid if purchasing through a dealer however. In this instance, ask the dealer for their warranty policy should you wish to return it.

The warranty period on this pedal is 5 years parts and labor (except due to abuse), and becomes valid only AFTER you register your pedal with us at http://www.wamplerpedals.com/warranty registration
