GETTING STARTED GUIDE

OVERVIEW

Launchkey Mini is a keyboard instrument that comes with integrated software for seamless music-making. The keyboard provides control over not only your existing music software (sometimes called a 'DAW') and the included V-Station and Bass Station software plug-ins, but also the Launchkey iPad synth app and the Launchpad iPad loop-triggering app. Together, this unique software-hardware combination allows instant, real time tweaking of synth parameters, loops and audio effect manipulation.

CONNECTING LAUNCHKEY MINI TO A COMPUTER

Connect your Novation Launchkey Mini keyboard to an available USB port on your Mac or PC using the supplied USB cable.



CONNECTING LAUNCHKEY MINI TO AN IPAD

Connect your Novation Launchkey Mini keyboard to your iPad using the supplied USB cable and an Apple Camera Connection Kit (not included) in the following order:

- 1. Connect the USB cable to the Launchkev Mini
- 2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to the Camera Connection Kit
- 3. Connect the Camera Connection Kit to your iPad



INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE

MAC/PC

Follow the instructions on the 'Software / Registration card' to install the following software:

- Novation V-Station synth plug-in
- Novation Bass Station plug-in
- Reason mapping installer (for Reason users only)



APPLE IPAD

Follow the instructions on the 'Software / Registration card' to install the following apps:

- Novation Launchkey iPad app
- Novation Launchpad iPad app





BASIC HARDWARE FEATURES

- 1 25 note mini-key synth-action keyboard
- 2 Knobs and buttons control a wide range of parameters in your DAW, such as the mixer and plug-ins. They also control parameters and effects in Novation iPad apps
- 3 Drum pads to trigger drum sounds or loops
- 4 'InControl' button to switch the operating mode of the knobs and pads:
 - a. Press once to toggle between InControl and Basic mode
 - b. Press and hold the InControl button and a pad (1-16) to select the MIDI Channel
- 5 Track up and down buttons to change the selected track in supported DAWs and switch between Novation iPad apps

IN CONTROL

INCONTROL OF YOUR MUSIC SOFTWARE

Launchkey Mini's unique 'InControl' mode is designed to work seamlessly with your Digital Audio Workstation (DAW). After configuring your DAW, the Launchkey Mini's knobs and pads can be used to control the DAW parameters that are most important to your workflow. Because every DAW is different, we've given each one its own unique mapping for Launchkey Mini.

Alternatively, if you wish your Launchkey Mini to operate as a standard MIDI keyboard, simply press and release the 'InControl button' to turn off 'InControl' and switch the knobs and pads back to basic MIDI mode.

NOTE: In most DAWs, 'pot pickup' is enabled by default. This means that knobs on the screen will move only when the physical control being moved has travelled past the position shown on the screen. This helps to avoid sudden jumps in parameters.
